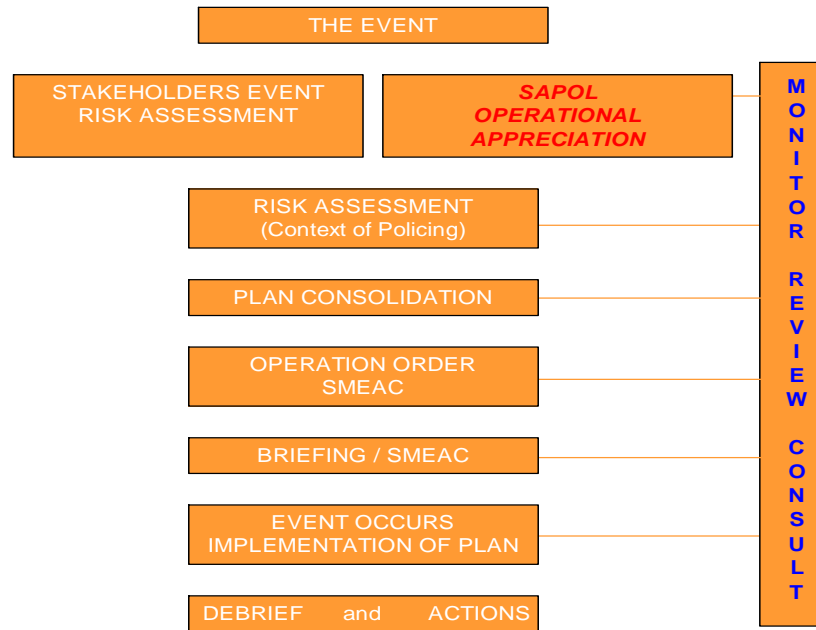

- Risk Identification
- Risk Assessment
- Risk Treatment
- Risk Apportionment
- Risk Review

Event Classification

- Clearly defined criteria for event planning ownership
 - Identified planning positions within SAPOL at Corporate and LSA level
- Local – Planned and Managed at local level
 - Special – Planned at Corporate level : Multiple resources need
 - Major – Planned at Corporate level : SAPOL resources need

AS/NZ Standard 4360 : 2004

Descriptor	Description
Rare	May occur in exceptional circumstances.
Unlikely	Could occur at some time.
Possible	Might occur at some time.
Likely	Will probably occur in most circumstances.
Almost Certain	Is expected to occur in most circumstances.

Likelihood	Consequences				
	Insignificant	Minor	Moderate	Major	Catastrophic
Almost certain	Moderate	Significant	Significant	High	High
Likely	Moderate	Moderate	Significant	Significant	High
Possible	Low	Moderate	Moderate	Significant	Significant
Unlikely	Low	Low	Moderate	Moderate	Significant
Rare	Low	Low	Low	Moderate	Significant

Descriptor	Description
Insignificant	No injuries, inconsequential or no damage, low financial loss.
Minor	First Aid treatment, some damage / disruption, medium financial loss.
Moderate	Medical treatment required, localised damage rectified by routine arrangements, high financial loss.
Major	Extensive injuries, loss of production capability, significant damage requiring external resources, major financial loss.
Catastrophic	Death, extensive damage, huge financial loss.

- Likelihood of issue
- Consequence if occurrence
- Level of risk

- Minimum IMOST trained
 - Operational Safety
- Vehicle permits
 - Vehicles, motorcycles, bikes
- Allocated logistics officer
 - Drinks, Weather, Members
- Remote Wireless Monitoring
 - University of Adelaide project



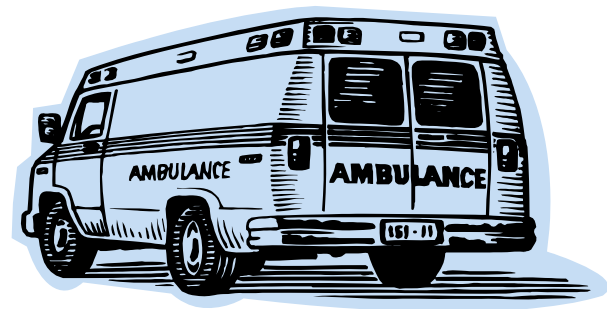
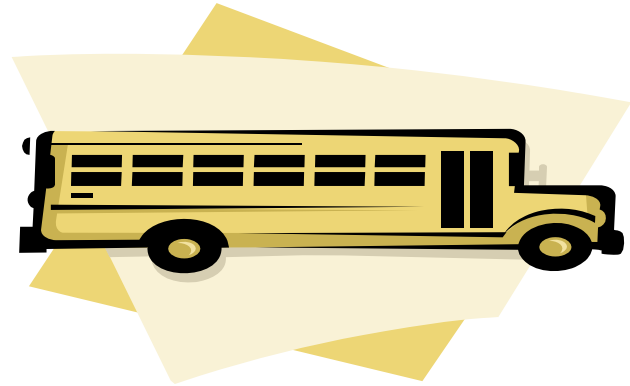

- Partnerships
- Greater emphasise on event producers to supply / control
- Command and Control
- Clearly defined roles and tasks
- Legislation

Security / Marshalling

- Use of only 'LICENCED' security personnel
- Working with security agencies re registered training programs
- Training 'support' personnel in Marshalling to 'free up' Emergency Service members
- Defined eviction policies
- Insist on Briefing & Debriefs
